- Inventory Support: collaborate with the Tack Store Manager to integrate sorted donations into the store's inventory system. Assist in arranging displays of donated items in the store to maximize visibility and accessibility.
- Price tagging & Item evaluation: develop pricing strategies based on items condition, brand, demand, and comparable market prices. Help track the value of donated items and their impact on the store's finances. Provide input on pricing suggestions for donated items to optimize revenue generation.
- Safety and Security: maintain a safe and secure environment for volunteers and customers by implementing safety protocols, conducting regular inspections, and addressing any safety concerns promptly.
